On 14 March 2025, the international SkillMe 2025 conference took place in Udine (Italy). We presented the CL-BVET project and the paper Involvement of employers in design and delivery of VET, which was presented by a representative of the project partner Tehnička škola Gradiška.

The conference was attended by a large number of students, in addition to the professional public, speakers and paper presenters. We are pleased to have presented the CL-BVET project to 150 participants from Italy, Slovenia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Austria and Croatia.







#### **NATIONAL EVENTS POST PLA1**

The national events held in February and March 2025 discussed and shared knowledge and experiences in education and training for collaborative learning in blended learning environments in the country.













A total of 118 experts from secondary vocational schools, educational institutions, universities, ministries of education and labour, agencies, companies, qualifications and quality institutions for vocational education participated in national post PLA1 events in the four partner countries.

Based on the findings, we will prepare a national analysis of the competences needed for collaborative learning by teachers and other VET providers.

The analysis will outline which competences need to be acquired or improved, and will draw up a set of competences that are the most important and necessary for collaborative learning.
